Talks by KOIAS Members at ZRS International Symposium in Koper, Slovenia

From June 17 to 19, 2025, the international symposium *Philosophy, Poetics, and Arts of Liminality: Interdisciplinary Perspectives* was held at the Centre for the Humanities of the Science and Research Centre (ZRS) in Koper, Slovenia. Co-organized by KOIAS member Alberto Parisi, the symposium brought together researchers from Europe, North America, and East Asia to explore the notion of liminality across philosophical, poetic, artistic, and cultural contexts.

Two KOIAS members delivered talks during the symposium. Alberto Parisi presented a paper titled “The Outside: The Subject’s Liminality from Bataille and Foucault to Nancy and Agamben,” while Yuho Hisayama gave a talk on “The Aesthetics of kehai in the Backrooms: An Essay on the Atmosphere of Liminal Spaces on the Internet.” Both talks highlighted the relevance of Atmospheric Studies in broader discussions of liminality.
