Agreement of Friendship and Cooperation Between Blanquerna Observatory (Ramon Llull University in Barcelona) and KOIAS

On May 18, 2026, Yuho Hisayama, Director of Kobe Institute for Atmospheric Studies (KOIAS), visited Blanquerna – Ramon Llull University in Barcelona, Spain. During the visit, he delivered a lecture entitled *“In the Thick of Atmosphere: Porosity, Difference, and Sensible Worlds.”*

On the same occasion, the Blanquerna Observatory on Media, Religion and Culture and KOIAS signed an Agreement of Friendship and Cooperation. Through this agreement, both institutions agreed to explore opportunities for collaboration, including the sharing of academic materials and the development of further international research networks in the fields of Communication Studies and Atmospheric Studies.
